MINUTES OF OCTOBER 16, 1978, were approved as written upon MOTION by Mr. Babcock, seconded by Mr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

TREASURER'S REPORT for October, was accepted upon MOTION by Mr. Babcock, seconded by Mr. Lehrman. Affirmative vote unanimous.

DISBURSEMENTS included vouchers #1 through #397 totaling \$304,212.26; fund transfers covered by vouchers #398 through #403 amounted to \$13,549.93.
