It is recommended that the enclosed Tech Prep Articulation Policy be approved by the College of Southern Idaho Board of Trustees. If approved it will be included in all Tech Prep Agreements.

TECH PREP ARTICULATION POLICY

The College of Southern Idaho will offer credit for articulated courses within approved tech prep programs. These courses must contain 90% of the competencies required within the appropriate college program course. Courses to be Articulated will be determined through cooperative agreement between the secondary and post-secondary instructors and included in a signed Tech Prep Articulation Agreement. The number of credits that can be articulated will be determined by the signed articulation agreement. A Grade of "P" will be transcripted at time of enrollment into the appropriate CSI program.

A student applying for articulated credit must:

- 1. Have been enrolled in high school tech prep program;
- 2. Receive a "B" or better in the articulated courses;
- 3. Meet all CSI Admission requirements;
- 4. Enrolled within two years of high school graduation.

To facilitate post-secondary program placement, it is recommended that a high school student complete a CSI application form at the time of entry into the high school tech prep program.
