Re: Campus Chip Coat Bids

We properly advertised for a chip coat for the main south parking lots, softball field parking lot and Health Sciences and Human Services Building parking lot as the base bid with add alternates for the Expo parking lot and the college portion of Frontier Road. We received the following bids:

C.A. Paving	\$260,000	\$45,000	\$21,000	\$326,000

Based upon a review of the bids by Allen Scherbinske and verification of the low bid, I recommend that we accept the low bid of Snake River Construction of Twin Falls, Idaho in the amount of \$160,500 for the base bid plus Alternate 1 and Alternate 2. I also request permission to negotiate additional chip coat work with the Snake River Construction up to the bid limit of \$25,000.

Funding for this project is from the Plant Facility Fund.
