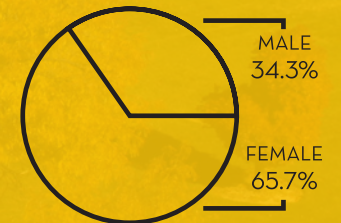

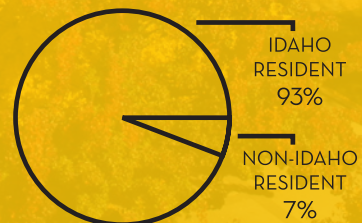

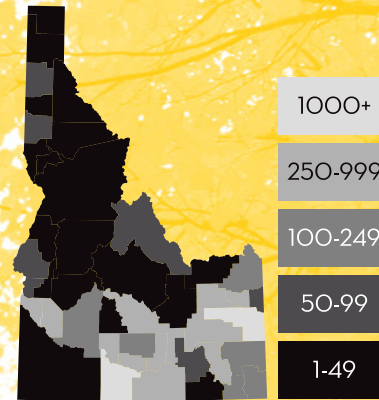

IDAHO OPPORTUNITY SCHOLARSHIP-ADULT LEARNER

For Idaho resident returning to college.
DEADLINE: Mar. 1 | MIN. GPA: 2.7 | ESSAY: No | AWARD: Up to \$3,500/year | RENEWABLE: Yes

IDAHO POSTSECONDARY CREDIT

For students with 10 or more postsecondary credits at time of high school graduation and a matching industry merit-based scholarship.
DEADLINE: Jun. 1 | MIN. GPA: N/A | ESSAY: Yes | AWARD: Varies | RENEWABLE: Yes

IDAHO GOVERNOR'S CUP

Graduating seniors from Idaho high schools. Requires community service.
DEADLINE: Academic-Feb. 15 • Profess/Tech-Apr. 15 | MIN. GPA: 2.8 | ESSAY: Yes | AWARD: \$3,000/year
RENEWABLE: Yes
