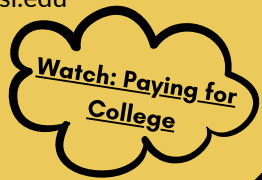

- **What is Net Partner?**
 - Net Partner is CSI's financial aid portal.
- **Where do I access it?**
 - Under the green "Finances" tab inside MyCSI. Login with your CSI credentials or call (208) 732-6311 for help.
- **Why is Net Partner important?**
 - Net Partner allows you to accept the awards you've been offered. You must electronically "accept" any financial awards like FAFSA or scholarships if you want to use them.
