CSI Radiologic Technology Program Technical Training Standards

Students must be able to perform the following physical standards:

- 1. Stoop to lift radiographic image receptors, grids, and other ancillary equipment.
- 2. Kneel to perform CPR and assist patients who may fall or faint.
- 3. Crouch to place imaging plates on the operating room table.
- 4. Reach with both hands at least 6 feet from the floor to overhead radiographic equipment.
- 5. Handle equipment such as overhead tubes, lead lined doors, portable machines, c-arm units, control panel knobs and buttons.
- 6. Maneuver patients in wheelchairs and stretchers, IV poles and oxygen tanks, patients on and off radiographic tables, and in and out of wheelchairs, and patients who may fall of faint.
- 7. Lift and place patient and image receptor for portable radiography (50 lbs or more).
- 8. Push portable c-arm and portable radiographic machines.
- 9. Walk for the duration of the assigned shift.
- 10. Wear lead aprons, thyroid shields, lead gloves, and lead crystal glasses.
- 11. Hear verbal directions / requests from physicians and patients; blood pressure sounds through a stethoscope; speed of rotor to take the exposure and termination sound; signals from CR plate reader.
- 12. See requisitions for information related to images; proper position of patients for images; proper equipment setup for images; proper exposure settings for images; motionlessness and respiratory phase of patient.
- 13. Talk to communicate in English to staff and patients.
- 14. Manipulate small objects such as knobs and buttons, needles and syringes (venipuncture).

Students must be able to perform the following mental / attitudinal standards:

- 15. Perform safely, effectively and calmly under stressful conditions.
- 16. Maintain composure while managing multiple tasks simultaneously.
- 17. Prioritize multiple tasks.
- 18. Exhibit social skills necessary (respect, politeness, tact, collaboration, teamwork, and discretion) to interact effectively with patients, families, supervisors and co-workers of the same or different culture.
- 19. Maintain personal hygiene.
