Honors Classes

Honors Program students take a four-semester series of honors seminar and reading classes that provide social, cultural, and academic enrichment. They are also required to take a number of honors core class sections to meet their general education requirements for CSI. These courses allow students to meet their general education requirements in an environment they share with serious students who have many of the same academic goals as themselves. These classes include sections of history, communication, psychology, English, education, and wellness. An accumulation of 15 honors credits merits special distinction on diplomas and transcripts.



Eagle View Lecture Series

The Honors Program coordinates the campus Eagle View Lecture Series. This lecture series brings speakers and authors to campus who offer diverse perspectives on regional and global issues. Honors Program students get special audiences with these speakers and are able to question and converse with them on a personal level.
